# Announcing the Program for Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021!

Online Broadcast Over 24 April (Sat) – 5 May (Wed/Holiday)

Tokyo Rainbow Pride (co-chairs: Fumino Sugiyama and Natsumi Yamada) is delighted to announce the program for Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021, a 12-day online event held from Saturday 24 April to Wednesday 5 May 2021. The 10th edition of Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021 will include a live broadcast of "#おうちでプライド 2021" featuring 16 special guests as well as content to help people learn about current LGBTQ issues.



The theme for Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021 is "Our Voices, Our Rights", and will be focal point for a series of online events, including "#おうちでプライド2021", a live talk show with special guests, the "Online Pride Parade", distributed to the public via SNS, "15 Things to Know About LGBTO Today", and "The Diversity of Families".

### 24 April (Sat) – 25 April (Sun) TRP2021 Online "#おうちでプライド2021" (13:00-18:00 both days)

#### 24 April (Sat) Online Pride Parade

The Pride Parade, the main event of Tokyo Rainbow Pride, will be held online again like last year.

Online content divided into themes relating to LGBTQ issues such as education, sports, legislation, disaster prevention, healthcare, the workplace, refugees, sexual violence, and provincial cities.

#### 5 May (Wed/Hol) "The Diversity of Families" (15:00-16:30)

The guest speakers are Yoshihisa Aono, Tomoko Kubota and Makiko Terahara. Fumino Sugiyama acts as the moderator of the webcast to discuss the future and diversity of the family unit.



#### 24 April (Sat) - 25 April (Sun) TRP2021 Online "#おうちでプライド2021" (13:00-18:00 both days)

The first program of Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021, #おうちでプライド2021 will be held over 24-25 April (Sat/Sun), featuring a total of 16 famous guests from a variety of fields. The event will run between 13:00-18:00 on both days under the theme of "Our Voices, Our Rights", with guests talking freely with each other and the audience.

#### 24 April (Sat) Online Pride Parade

The Online Parade will be held on Saturday 24 April. To participate, post on SNS sites (Twitter, Instagram, Facebook) with the two hashtags #おうちでプライド2021 and #声をあげる世界を変える and tell us any issues you face and changes you wish to see in schools, workplaces, communities, and social rules, values, and systems. The Pride Parade, the symbol of Tokyo Rainbow Pride, will be held online so that those unable to travel to Tokyo and those who wish to remain anonymous can participate.

#### 5 April (Mon) - 5 May (Wed/Hol) "15 Things to Know About LGBTQ Today"

Every day during Pride Week (Monday 26 April to Wednesday 5 May), we will be delivering online content divided into themes such as LGBTQ and education, sport, legislation, disaster prevention, healthcare, the workplace, refugees, sexual violence and local cities. Each session will last 20 minutes, allowing participants to discuss LGBTQ issues from various perspectives.

However, while the terms "LGBTQ" and "diversity" have integrated themselves into our society, it has become clear that, to create a society in which everyone can live freely, there are some matters that remain unresolved. In this content, we aim to help solve this problem by deepening understanding of LGBTQ and diverse values and lifestyles throughout Japanese society, and by making more people aware of the various issues that arise from persistent discrimination and prejudice.

## 5 May (Wed/Hol) "The Diversity of Families -Selective surnames, special adoptions, and same-sex marriage-" (15:00-16:30)

On 5 May, the last day of Tokyo Rainbow Pride 2021, we will welcome three guests for a live broadcast on the theme of "family" from 15:00. As individual lifestyles continue to diversify, so too does the nature of the family. This talk considers the future of the family unit by sharing various perspectives on such issues as selective surnames, special adoptions, and same-sex marriage.

We need the policies to change across all gender, races, and beliefs so that everyone can be equal and live happy, fulfilling lives


